She is also a voice for the *Silent No More Awareness Campaign*, sharing her testimony of two abortions, God's forgiveness, and healing.

Vicki Thorn is the foundress of Project Rachel & the executive director of the National Office of Post-Abortion Reconciliation & Healing located in Milwaukee. Vicki is an international speaker & author on topics of abortion's aftermath in women, men and others as well as the biology of bonding & attachment.

Richard Doerflinger is the associate director for Policy Development at the Secretariat for Pro-Life Activities of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops. He is a highly respected expert on federal policy regarding abortion, euthanasia and biomedical research.

Mary-Louise Kurey is the Respect Life Director for the Archdiocese of Chicago. As Miss Wisconsin, Mary-Louise chose abstinence as her platform for the 1999 Miss America pageant. She since has addressed more than 130,000 teens and college students about postponing sexual activity until marriage, and "making a new beginning" for those who have been sexually active.

Fr. Peter Mitchell is an instructor in Latin and Theology at St. Gregory the Great Seminary in Seward, NE.

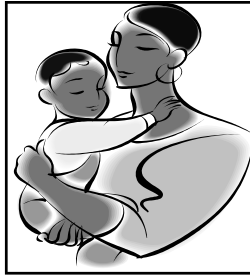
