## LB 50 ACTION ALERT

**LB 50, the Elementary and Secondary Educational Opportunity Act**, would allow individuals, married couples, and businesses to claim a state income tax credit for a portion of their donations to Scholarship-Granting Organizations to help children attend privately-operated elementary and secondary schools in Nebraska. The bill would provide a tax incentive to encourage donations to Scholarship-Granting Organizations, creating a new source of resources to help limited-income families to afford the cost of private-school tuition.
